LAFPP Operating Policies and Procedures Section 1.18 (Contractor Disclosure Policy)

Application (See Appendix A of the Policy for Definitions)

Except as otherwise provided, this policy applies to Contractors and its Officers, marketing representatives, relationship representatives, portfolio managers, members of the investment committee, and Intermediaries, involved in the product or service provided or sought to be provided to LAFPP. This policy also applies to Family Members (spouse or domestic partners) of the individuals referenced above.

Reporting Type (Section 1.18.B.3)

(1) Initial Disclosures - For new contracts/investments, Contractors are required to complete a Contractor Disclosure Form and disclose reportable items (as defined by this Policy) that occurred during the twenty-four (24) month period prior to Board approval of a new contract. For private equity partnerships, including general partners, disclosure information for the prior twenty-four month period shall be provided at the time the Board considers a new or additional investment in a private equity fund.

Example: Company A is interviewing for an LAFPP contract in January 2021. As a result, Company A must file an Initial Disclosure Filing with LAFPP for a two-year "lookback" reporting period of 1/1/2019 to 1/1/2021.

(2) Periodic Disclosures - For existing contracts, most Contractors are required to complete a Contractor Disclosure form quarterly (except for Private Equity Partnerships and certain non-investment and non-legal Contractors). Quarterly disclosures are due 21 business days after the end of the quarter.

Example: Company A is selected by the Board as a Contractor in July 2021, but the contract is not finalized until August 2021 (Q3). Starting with Q3, Company A must now submit a quarterly Periodic Disclosure Filing. Their first Periodic Disclosure Filing will cover Q3 and be due by 11/1/2021.

Gift Reporting Threshold (Section 1.18.E)

Gifts must be reported in the period where the total value of gifts made/received to a single recipient/source in a calendar year is \$50 or more. A flowchart outlining your potential reporting obligations is provided at LAFPP.com
